2.3 Accessibility

Accessibility is a basic concept of the Fabasoft Cloud. To enable working with assistive technologies like screen readers or screen magnifiers Fabasoft Cloud follows following standards:

- Accessible Rich Internet Applications (WAI-ARIA) 1.0
- Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0, ISO/IEC 40500:2012, Conformity Level AA
- ISO 9241-171:2008 Guidance on software accessibility

Following screen readers are recommended for the use with the Fabasoft Cloud:

- Microsoft Windows
 - NVDA (NonVisual Desktop Access) with Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome
 - JAWS 2018 with Microsoft Internet Explorer, Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox
- Apple iPhone/iPad
 - VoiceOver (Fabasoft Cloud App)
- Android
 - TalkBack (Fabasoft Cloud App; TalkBack provides only a restricted support in older Android versions)

Note: VoiceOver and TalkBack provide only a restricted support for WAI-ARIA. Consequently, the web browser user interface cannot be used with these screen readers.

3 The Fabasoft Cloud Client

The Fabasoft Cloud Client is necessary for a close integration with desktop productivity tools, such as Microsoft Office or LibreOffice. The Fabasoft Cloud Client is available on all reference platforms described in chapter 2.1 "Desktop".

If you have the Fabasoft Cloud Client installed, you have the following upload possibilities:

Note:

- In case the Fabasoft Cloud Client is not installed on your desktop already, you will be asked to install it when logging in.
- The maximum file size is 16 gigabytes.
- The Cloud Folder (synchronization with the file system) supports on Microsoft Windows local NTFS 3.1 file systems and on Apple macOS local HFS+ or APFS file systems.
Note: Each Cloud Folder is assigned to exactly one user and workstation. Therefore, it is not supported that several users synchronize in the same Cloud Folder or that one user synchronizes from several workstations in the same Cloud Folder.

4 The Fabasoft Cloud Enterprise Client

The installation of software in a user's local profile is often not possible in an enterprise environment (e.g. users are not allowed to execute MSI packages or the software must be installed on a terminal server). In this case you may use the Enterprise Client. This Client is installed for all users on a computer (so-called "per machine" installation) and can be distributed centrally by administrators.
